Dear Parent/Carer

To support students with accessing home learning resources during the current national lockdown the Department for Education (DfE) are piloting a scheme to increase mobile data allowances for children and young people. The scheme is open to families who meet the following criteria:

1. Do not have access to a fixed broadband connection.
2. Cannot afford the additional data needed to access educational resources or social care services.
3. Have access to a mobile device that uses a participating network (networks stated below).
4. Are facing disruption to their face-to-face education or have been advised not to attend school.

The mobile networks that are taking part within this scheme are shown below, along with the specific details of the allowances they are offering.

Mobile network	Data allowances
EE	20 GB of additional data per month until 31 <sup>st</sup> July 2021
Sky Mobile	100 GB of additional data
Smarty	Unlimited data until 31 <sup>st</sup> July 2021
Tesco Mobile	20 GB of additional data per month until 31 <sup>st</sup> July 2021
Three	Unlimited data until 31 <sup>st</sup> July 2021
Virgin Mobile	20 GB of additional data per month until 31 <sup>st</sup> July 2021

If you would like to take up the offer and meet the eligibility criteria for the scheme, please contact us at [Midpoint.school@wolverhampton.gov.uk](mailto:Midpoint.school@wolverhampton.gov.uk) with the following information:

1. Account holder's name for the device
2. Mobile phone number
3. Mobile network (must be one of those stated above)
4. If the mobile is pay monthly or pay as you go
5. Confirmation you have read and agree to the privacy policy (below). This must be confirmation from an adult if the child is under 13 years of age.

The details above will then be uploaded to the DfE website for processing. Additional information about the timescales for the data allowance to be added to the account will be shared with you individually.

**Privacy statement: Department for Education (January 2021)**

Please share the following privacy statement with:

- the adult account holder for the mobile device
- the parent or carer of the person benefiting from the offer if they are under 13
- the person benefiting from the offer if they are 13 or over

1. For the purposes of data protection, I need to let you know that the Department for Education (DfE) is running the Mobile Network Offer through schools and their trusts or local authorities.

2. If the offer is taken up by an adult account holder, the school or social care team will share the account holder's name and mobile phone details with the DfE, who will share these with the relevant mobile network operator.

3. The mobile network operator will use that information to increase the data available for the account holder's mobile device, as long as they qualify for the offer.

4. The adult account holder's personal data is only shared with their mobile network operator for the purposes of the offer. No names of children or other adults, other than adult account holder, are shared with the DfE or the mobile network operator.

5. No personal information will be shared with the DfE if you do not want to take up the offer.

6. If you want to know more about how your personal information will be used before you take up the offer, we can send that to you first.

7. If you decide to take up the offer, you will get a text message from the Department for Education with more information about your data protection rights.
