

Nursery Home Learning Bingo – How many can you do?

Spend some time doing some baking with someone in your family.



Find some bears and have a Goldilocks tea party! Can you find a small bear, big bear and middle-sized bear?




Build a den and share a story inside it!

Markmaking! Can you make patterns. Use paint, pencils, pens, whatever you like!



Be an artist! Draw or paint a picture of someone in your home. Think about the colours you would need for their eyes and hair.



Make up a dance! Put on some music to listen to and make your own dance to it!



Set up an exercise circuit at home. Make a jumping station, a running station and a stretching station.



Play a memory game. Collect 10 small objects from around the house and put them on a tray. Ask the other person to look away while you take one away. Can they guess which one you took? Keep a tally of the scores. How many did they guess correctly?

You can continue to support your child's learning by continuing these daily activities:

1. Do a daily weather report. Is it sunny, rainy, warm or cold?



2. What can you find to count each day? You could count your toys back into the toy box when you tidy, or the plates out onto the table for dinner.
3. Share a story and talk about the characters and events. Or encourage your child to tell you a story using the pictures in the book.
4. Share the day, ask them about what they enjoyed most each day.
5. Encourage imaginative play by setting up a small world, use toy figures but you could also make trees and buildings out of boxes and cardboard.
